Inside and Out

This month's block lotto was inspired by a quilt a friend recently posted on social media. I love the simplicity of the block and how fast it comes together. This is also another great stash buster for the those leftover jelly strips!

There are no required fabrics this month, but we are asking that your light color piecing be low volume and light grays. Please see the examples below of light gray, low volume fabrics. The color piecing can be anything bright, bold or beautiful. Solids and prints are all fair game. Use a scant ½" seam allowance and press to towards the color pieces in both options.

For each block you will need the following

A: Cut two 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" pieces

B: Cut two 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" pieces

C: Cut one 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" piece

Step 1.


Using a scant 1/4" seam allowance, sew one B piece to the C piece and press towards the colored piece.

Repeat with the second B piece.


Step 2.

Using a scant 1/4" seam allowance, sew one A piece to the B & C pieces and again press towards the colored piece. Repeat using the second A piece.

And you're done! Your block should be 6-1/2" x 12-1/2". Now make another!!!




