# Proposed By Law Change



#### Current 4.5.1

- Elected officers may not serve more than one consecutive term in any one office.
- Exists to prevent one person or a group of people from running over and over again.
- Change is good.

## Proposed Change

- Elected officers may not serve more than one consecutive term in any one office, unless at the end of the term there is no new nominee. If there is no nominee then the current officer, if they choose, may be the nominee for their current position.
- This is a voluntary option.
- The nominee must still be elected by the membership
- Vote will be held at November meeting

## Why?

- Lack of nominees to fill positions
- Board positions need to be filled
- Current board members may wish to continue in their position, and this would permit that for one more term.
